Stellenbosch (1679) is the oldest town in South Africa and the nearby Paarl (1683) and Franschhoek (1688) are well-known stops in most tour programmes. Each of these villages has something very special to offer the visitor. This day tour will expose you to some of those highlights, and will afford you the opportunity to also taste some of the top quality wines produced in the Cape Winelands.

08:30 Your touring vehicle will take you from the conference venue directly to the Afrikaans Language Monument in Paarl, for a guided tour of the grounds.

10:00 At the KWV, largest wine company in SA, a cellar tour will be followed by a tasting of selected products, and then there will be some free time to also purchase some of the quality liquor.

12:00 By midday a short drive will take you into the town of Franschhoek, where you will view the Huguenot Memorial at the top of the town, and where you will also have some free time to wonder along the main street of Franschhoek.

13:15 A light lunch is now enjoyed at a selected farm kitchen.

14:30 After lunch you now make your way back towards Stellenbosch, travelling via the Helshoogte Pass, with its beautiful views of the surrounding valleys.

15:15 The final stop for the day is at the Lanzerac Wine Estate, where you will enjoy a wine and chocolate tasting. This is an eye-opening experience.

16:30 *En route* back to the Spier Estate, you will undertake a motorized tour of the town of Stellenbosch – with its oak lined streets, high number of students, street café's and many historic buildings – arguably one of the most beautiful towns in the world.
