<p>Day 2 Friday 2 November 2012</p>	<p>After an early breakfast, a shuttle vehicle will bring you to the Cape Town International Airport in time to check in for your flight to Johannesburg.</p> <p><b><i>NOTE: The booking of the Cape Town/Johannesburg flight is your own responsibility. However, Cape AgriTours can assist you with the booking/s of the flight/s. You will no be traveling as a group. Your touring vehicle will be ready and waiting and you will make your way directly to the world renowned Kruger National Park (KNP). On arrival at the park (Numbi Gate) you will check in at the Nkambeni Private Tented Lodge, in time to enjoy an optional light lunch.</p> <p>After some free time to relax, or to enjoy the pool at the lodge, you will depart on the first of your open vehicle game drives, as you travel to the traversing area of the lodge. Here you will go in search of the nocturnal animals of the African bush. These creatures are not normally seen during the day.
