Flights from and back to South Africa, or onward, are not included in the package.

Fully guided/chaperoned options are available on request.

Your overnight stay the night before departure is suggested at one of the many hotel options near the O.R. Tambo International Airport, Johannesburg. The Emperors Palace Casino complex with its many restaurants, is the most convenient, and offers four hotels in different categories.

Day 1: Saturday, 11 November of Monday, 13 November 2017 (B / - / D)

After a leisurely breakfast, make your way (07:45) to the O.R. Tambo International Airport for a morning flight* to Livingstone in Zambia or Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. You should arrive there around midday. Be sure to have or get the right visas!! YOU WILL REQUIRE AT LEAST A DOUBLE ENTRY VISA – these can be purchased at the point of entry. Your shuttle driver will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel on the banks of the great Zambezi River. Check in and relax. At sundown you then undertake the Zambezi River Cruise with drinks and snacks (included in the hotel package, but **note: the USD30 river fee has to be paid to the operator at the hotel office**). Dinner is enjoyed at your hotel.

Day 2: Sunday, 12 November or Tuesday, 14 November 2017 (B / - / D)

After a leisurely breakfast your local guide will collect you and transfer you to the great Victoria Waterfalls – Mosi-oa-Tunya or “the smoke that thunders”. **The tour is included in the hotel package, but the USD20 fee to enter the Victoria Falls Park is paid at the gate.** Free time will be available to view the falls (hopefully from both the Zambian and Zimbabwean sides and to view and spend time with the curio traders at the falls). Today a helicopter flight (about 1hr required) over the falls will be an optional extra and is a definite suggestion. This is the perfect alternative of seeing the falls – from a bird’s eye-view. For tonight, dinner is again included at your hotel.




Day 3: Monday, 13 November or Wednesday, 15 November 2017 (B / L / -)

The full day is devoted to a trip to the Chobe Game Reserve in Botswana, where you can experience the grandeur of nature in a very special way. This is a guided tour and returns to Livingstone or Victoria Falls in the late afternoon. Tonight **dinner** is enjoyed at own leisure, either your own hotel, or a nearby venue.

Overnight Livingstone/Victoria Falls

*Clients are picked up from their hotel/lodge between 07h00 and 07h15 and transferred by road to the ferry at the Kazungula border post. Clients will then cross the Zambezi on a private boat to the Kasane border post, clear Immigration and Customs (visas for their own account) then transfer to Mowana Lodge (bathroom facilities). From here clients will depart on a 3 hour game drive into the Chobe National Park (soft drinks and park entry fees included). Clients are then returned to Mowana Lodge for a **buffet lunch** (lunch is included but drinks are for the guests own account, payable direct). After lunch, guests will depart on a 3 hour boat cruise into the Chobe National Park. On returning to Mowana, guests are then transferred back to the Kazungula border post by private boat transfer arriving at approximately 16h45 – 17h00. They will then be transferred by road back to their hotel/lodge arriving at approx. 18h00. Drinks on the cruise and drive include coke, lemonade, still mineral water and sparkling mineral water.*



Day 4: Tuesday, 14 November or Thursday, 16 November 2017 (B / - / -)

After breakfast and check out, guests will be transferred back to either the Livingstone or the Victoria Falls Airports, from where you will join your outbound flights to Johannesburg. Here you then join your return flights back home.
