

Luxury Beach & Bush Safari

The Western Cape and a leading private game lodge

In short:

This is a short and compact trip to the Southern tip of Africa. It will expose you the highlights of the Western Cape, where it is scattered around the “Mother City” – Cape Town. A domestic flight then brings you to the heart of our wildlife conservation – the Kruger National Park (KNP), where you will stay at an amazing private lodge.

Highlights:

- Experience the cultural highlights of the Western, including food and wine, dating back nearly 375 years
- Table Mountain and the views from the top
- The Cape Peninsula & Cape Point
- Exclusive day in the Cape Winelands
- Incredible wildlife safari in the Kruger Park region, from Jock's your Private Safari Lodge



Day 0: Friday, 2026 (Meals on board)

Overnight flight/s from Europe to Cape Town. Various airlines offer direct flights from European hubs to Cape Town.

Day 1: Saturday, 2026 (Meals on board / D)

On the arrival of your overnight flight into Cape Town, and after the normal custom procedures, a representative of Cape AgriTours and your English-speaking (*other languages are available on request*) tourist guide for the trip will meet you and escort you to your waiting touring vehicle. Weather permitting, you will then make your way directly to Table Mountain, the majestic sandstone bastion guarding over the “Mother City” of SA – Cape Town. Ascend the mountain by cable car and spend some free time on the big flat top. Today the mountain is one of the new 7 Wonders of Nature, a World Heritage site and a National Monument. As you may be on the mountain by lunchtime, it will be a good idea to enjoy something to eat and drink here. From the mountain, you will make your way via Hout Bay and Noordhoek Village directly to the Long Beach,

which is right on the beach in the picturesque lobster-fishing village of Kommetjie, a short drive from the city. The eight-kilometer-long beach of fine white sand, set against a backdrop of blue mountains, makes for the most stunning sea views and offers Cape Town's most romantic hideaway – on just a handful of places where the sea is on your doorstep. Watching the sunset over the Atlantic Ocean, you can step off the pool deck outside your elegant suite, straight onto the unspoiled dunes. Breakfasts are served overlooking the pool deck and the beach, with lunch and dinners available on request in the elegant dining room.

Dinner is enjoyed at the hotel.

The Last Word's Long Beach (5*)

Day 2: Sunday, 2026 (B / L / -)

No trip to South Africa can ever be complete with undertaking the Grand Tour of the Cape Peninsula.

Your guide will meet you at the hotel, and then you will make your way to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, where you will view both the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point. You will then make your way to Simon's Town, where a **seafood lunch** will be enjoyed at the Seaforth Restaurant. After lunch, there will be time to visit the African penguin breeding colony on Boulders Beach, before finally today, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

After the late lunch, dinner will be optional tonight.

Day 3: Monday, 2026 (B / L / -)

South Africa is very well known for our quality wines, so today is dedicated to the Winelands of the Cape. After breakfast transfer directly to Stellenbosch – Heart of the Cape Winelands and a beautiful university town that nestles in a valley surrounded by fabulous mountains. It is the oldest town in SA, and first to be established (1679) after the city of Cape Town. Three elegant wine tastings – at either Waterford Wine Estate or Ernie Els Wines to the south of town, and at Tokara Wine Estate in Helshoogte Pass, finished off with a **superb lunch**, will fill the morning, while the Asara Estate to the west and on the way back to the city, will be a special place to finish the afternoon. You will be returned to your hotel in the latter part of the afternoon. Dinner is at own leisure.

OR

Spend the full day experiencing the vibrant Mother City, as Cape Town is affectionately referred to. Visit Table Mountain (as back-up to D1), the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, shop for souvenirs at the Flea-Market on Greenmarket Square or take a pleasure cruise out to Table Bay – maybe on the Pirate Ship or a yacht! You will be returned to your hotel in the latter part of the afternoon. Dinner is at own leisure.

Day 4: Tuesday, 2026 (B / L / D)

After an early breakfast and check-out, your southern touring vehicle will be ready to take you directly to Cape Town's International Airport, for a direct flight to the Kruger-Mpumalanga International Airport (MQP) near Mbombela (formerly Nelspruit). You will be use flight FA670 (09:00-11:30).

On arrival at Mbombela you will be met and transferred to your luxury game lodge situated in the famed Kruger National Park. Jock Safari Lodge incorporates the romance and elegance of the colonial era and reflects in its unique style the indigenous Zulu and Shangaan cultures. This was the first private lodge to be granted a concession in the Kruger National Park (KNP). The luxury suites each have their own private sala and plunge pool overlooking the river, as do the romantic bathrooms and outdoor showers. Sighting of animals including the Big Five can be seen while relaxing around the rock pool or from the comfort and privacy of your own room.

Day 5: Wednesday, 2026 (B / L / D)

At five in the morning, you are woken by a soft knocking on your door (only if one wishes of course). Enjoy morning tea and muffins with your ranger, before leaving the lodge to catch the sunrise and animal viewing. By the time you return from the morning game drive all the morning staff are at camp, where breakfast will be ready. After your hearty breakfast you may choose to enjoy a bush walk, depending on your personal fitness levels, it normally takes one to two hours. The Game

Rangers offer fauna and flora talks and magnificent rock art viewing. Each topic is discussed and guests are welcome to set the pace as they wish. There is of course always the good possibility of encountering the animals on foot. On returning to the lodge, you can relax in the suite or wallow in the pool before a delicious lunch. You don't have to have a formal sit-down lunch, but you can order and enjoy it in the privacy of your sala. The evening game drive starts around 16h30, with a cool box sundowners and snacks on board. The ranger will stop so you can watch the sun going down in Africa. En route back to your lodge, nocturnal animals such as leopards, hyenas and lions are often seen.

Day 6: Thursday, 2026 (B / L / D)

A full day of game activities, including two open vehicle game drives and an optional bush walk. Your lodge is nestled amidst lush vegetation with 6000 hectares of natural landscape. With exclusive riverbed traversing rights make game drives a personal experience with exquisite photographic opportunities. Enthralling sightings of elephants, prides of lions as well as a sea of buffalo horns rising from the grass as they lie resting in the growing heat, awaits you. Food is very much a part of the safari experience and dining under African skies is what dreams are made of. Riverbed dining under a canopy of stars is a memorable experience. The lodge's unique location offers you an exceptional setting to savour traditional, barbecue style feasts by the warmth of a campfire, surrounded by the sounds and wonders of the African wilderness.

Day 6: Friday, 2026 (B / L / D)

A final pre-dawn wake-up call will once more get you ready for the continental breakfast and morning game drive. You will again be returned to the lodge in time for that wonderful breakfast, and then it will be time to refresh and check out, getting ready for your shuttle transfer to the Kruger-Mpumalanga Airport.

You need to be at the airport by 10:45 or 14:00 (depending on your flight), to check in for a domestic flight 4Z842 (12:45-13:40) or 4Z822 (16:15-17:10) to JNB. Here you will then cross over to the international departure area, to check in for your return flights to Europe.
