#### In short:

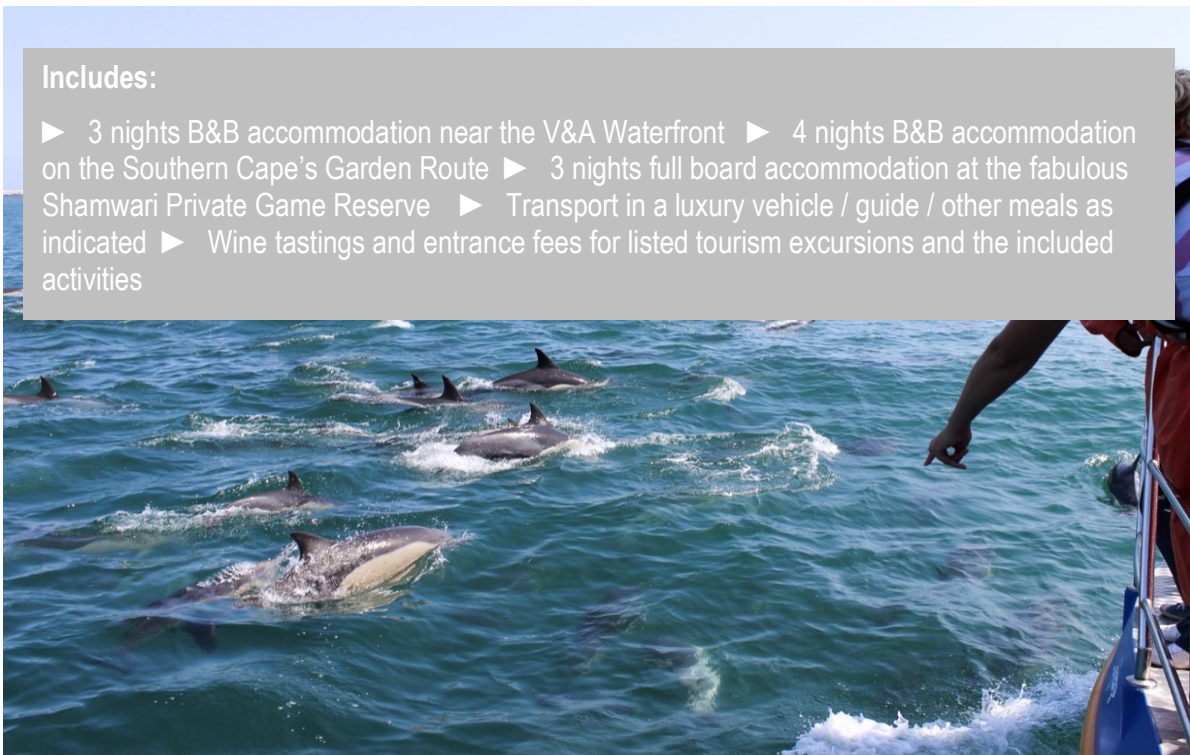

#### Day 0: Friday, 2026 (Meals on board)

Overnight flight/s from Europe to Cape Town. Various airlines offer direct flights from European hubs to Cape Town, Johannesburg and Durban.

#### Day 1: Saturday, 2026 (Meals on board / D)

On arrival in the “Mother City”, as Cape Town is lovingly called, and when you have gone through customs, a representative of Cape AgriTours, and your English-speaking (other languages by special request) guide for the tour will meet you and assist you to your touring vehicle. Weather permitting (we ALWAYS do this first, as we can get four seasons in a day), you will then make your way directly to Table Mountain, the majestic sandstone bastion guarding over Cape Town. Ascend the mountain by cable car and spend some free time on the big flat top. Today the mountain is one of the new 7 Wonders of Nature, a World Heritage site and a National Monument. As you will probably be on the mountain around lunchtime, it could be a good idea to enjoy something to eat or drink.

From the mountain, a short orientation tour of the city is undertaken as you make your way to your V&A Waterfront hotel. On arrival, you can check in and get your room with sufficient free time to refresh and relax, before you will then enjoy a

welcome dinner at a selected venue – either at the hotel, or somewhere close by. After dinner the rest of the evening is then spent at own leisure.

### **Day 2: Sunday, 2026 (B / - / -)**

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at your hotel, then your guide will meet you and take you on an adventure through Cape Town. Take a stroll along the Atlantic Seaboard, maybe the children would like to take the little blue train ride or visit the Greenpoint Lighthouse. The Sea Point promenade is always alive and buzzing, with great artworks on display. You will then travel to Bantry Bay, Clifton and Camps Bay, before heading back into the city, visiting some landmarks like the Company Gardens, the Planetarium, South African museum and the Greenmarket Square – a flea-market. Grab a bite to eat whilst exploring, there is enough healthy variety to satisfy the whole family's tastebuds. Return to your hotel in the afternoon, with the evening at leisure to enjoy all the offerings at the Waterfront.

### **Day 3: Monday, 2026 (B / L / -)**

This morning your tour guide will meet you after breakfast and take you on a tour of the Cape Peninsula. First activity today will be a scenic cruise from Hout Bay to view the Cape Fur seals on Duiker Island, then the scenic Chapmans Peak drive before visiting the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Beware of the naughty baboons! Take a walk up to the lighthouse for magnificent views before heading to **lunch** in Simons Town. After lunch visit the Boulders Beach penguin colony, where you might want to take a swim as well. Last stop is the lovely little fishing village of Kalk Bay where the family might indulge in some ice cream before heading to the hotel for the evening.

### **Day 4: Tuesday, 2026 (B / - / -)**

After breakfast followed by check out, you will travel along the beautiful Clarence Drive to Hermanus, lovingly referred to as the Riviera of the South. Here you can take the cliff path, maybe spotting some whales and stop for lunch on the rocks. You will depart on your journey to a magical hideaway deep in the Elgin Valley. Stop at a great little farmstall for some snacks before arriving at Old Mac Daddy for check in. This afternoon you can take in the fresh air, great views and from your funky Airstream trailer. You will have open spaces, mountain paths, a lakeside beach and plenty of activities for the whole family to enjoy.

### **Day 5: Wednesday, 2026 (B / - / -)**

Depart after breakfast and check out with your tour guide on your journey to the Southern-most tip of Africa. Visit the Agulhas lighthouse and enjoy a barefoot beach picnic in the Agulhas National Park. Another memorable stop could be made at Struisbaai harbour where you might be lucky enough to spot some of the friendly short-tailed Stingrays in the bay. Your journey then takes you inland towards the town of Swellendam. Arrive at your river resort in the late afternoon. The Sonderend and Breede Rivers meet on this Overberg farm, allowing for plenty of river activities for the whole family. Your elevated tent overlooks the resort and the beautiful farm landscape. The outdoor wood-fired hot tub next to your tent will be a highlight for all family members!

### **Day 6: Thursday, 2026 (B / - / D)**

This glamping experience offers plenty of family-friendly activities. You could try your luck at fishing from the banks of the Breede River, play some mini-golf, swim in the river, or enjoy the three swimming pools with slides. Your custom-designed glamping tent is fully furnished with everything you need for a comfortable self-catering stay. You will also have convenient meal hampers (including a traditional South African Braai Box) to choose from. There is also cycling, hiking, or you could head to the historic town of Swellendam or the Marloth Nature Reserve.

**Day 7: Friday, 2025 (B / - / -)**

After breakfast, you will depart on your journey through the Southern Cape to your historic hotel in Storms River Village along the Garden Route. This beautiful area is a hive of activity, mountain hikes, treetop canopy tours, segway forest tours, kayaking, nearby beaches, black water tubing and more is on offer, and it is right on your doorstep.

**Day 8: Saturday, 2025 (B / L / D)**

After your laid-back breakfast and check out, your tour guide will transfer you from Tsitsikamma, through Gqeberha (previously known as Port Elizabeth) to the Shamwari Private Game Reserve. This malaria-free private game reserve is positively bursting with free roaming wild animals, birdlife and indigenous Flora and Fauna. This safari experience will remain with you forever. Due to its ideal location in the Eastern Cape, the reserve offers unforgettable encounters with nature.

**Shamwari Riverdene Lodge**

**Days: 9 & 10, Sunday & Monday (B / L D)**

Game drives depart twice a day and are included in your stay. Your lodge offers a range of child-friendly activities (children 4+ are welcome on family game drives too). There is a swimming pool with shallow area, a kids club and outdoor adventure center. Enjoy guided walks, visit the Born Free Big cat sanctuary, or the Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre. Family travel is one of the best ways for parents and children to bond, and Shamwari Riverdene will deliver family relaxation. With conservation at the heart of the reserve, you will experience all its conservation initiatives. And whilst you relax, the children enjoy a host of activities to keep them active and happy, from climbing walls to ziplines as well as indoor craft activities.

**Day 11: Tuesday (B / meals on board)**

You will be met at your lodge after one last exciting game drive and bush breakfast, after which you are transferred to the Port Elizabeth Airport. Your connecting flight can be to either JNB or CPT, depending from where your outbound flight back to Europe is from.
