Golf and Safari tour to the Western Cape of South Africa

In short:

South Africa has become a golfing Mecca to world, with more than 520 golf courses now being available for play. Weather wise, golf is possible all year round, but please note, on Wednesday's and Saturday's most clubs run their local club competitions, and then most don't allow visitors to play there.

This tour was originally designed for Reijo Linna, PGA Member (Finland) and club professional at the Kokkolan Golf Club. The tour has been conducted successfully any number of times, and 2026 without any doubt was the same.

This is a 14-day/13-night golf safari to the Western Cape of South Africa. It includes 8 rounds of golf at some of the leading courses in and around the city of Cape Town and the Winelands of the Cape; features a one-night stay at a private safari lodge; while sufficient time is allowed for the local wine and food culture; and experiencing the top tourism sites of the Cape.

Highlights:

- Experiencing the cultural highlights of the Western, including food and wine, dating back nearly 375 years
- 8 rounds on fabulous golf courses
- Table Mountain and the views from the top
- The Cape Peninsula & Cape Point
- One night full board stay & game drives at a Private Safari Lodge

Day 0: Sunday, 10 January 2027 (meals on board)

Depart from Europe to South Africa. Various airlines offer direct flights from European hubs to Cape Town.

The cost of the flight is not included in the price of this tour.

Day 1: Monday, 11 January 2027 (B / - / D)

Your long-haul flight to Cape Town should arrive in the "Mother City" during the course of the morning. A representative of Cape AgriTours and your tourist guide for the tour will meet you and escort you to your touring vehicle. Weather permitting, you will make your way directly to Table Mountain, majestic sandstone bastion guarding over the city of Cape Town, and is one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature. There will be some free time on the mountain to enjoy something light to eat or simply enjoy your first beer on South African soil. From the mountain your touring vehicle will then bring you to your hotel in the V&A Waterfront. Check in and relax. Your welcome **dinner** will be enjoyed at a selected restaurant close to the hotel.

Day 2: Tuesday, 12 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After a leisurely breakfast you will make your way directly to the Pro Shop – the number one golf shop in South Africa. You will have sufficient time to do some golf shopping before making your way to the first round of golf in the city environment, which will be played at the Westlake Golf Course (#99 in South Africa / 14th in the Western Cape)(R1) on the Northern slope of Steenberg Mountain. There is a practice range where you can get loose before you play the first round. Late-morning / early afternoon tee-times will be requested. After golf, return to your city hotel.

Dinner is enjoyed at own leisure in the Waterfront or similar.

Overnight Cape Town

Day 3: Wednesday, 13 January 2027 (B / L / -)

No trip to South Africa can ever be complete with undertaking the Grand Tour of the Cape Peninsula. Departing from your hotel, travel via Maidens Cove (photo stop) to Hout Bay harbour, from where a short boat cruise (09:15) will take you out to Duiker Island to view the colony of Cape fur seals and some other aquatic life. On your return to the mainland, there will be some free time to bargain with the curio traders on the quayside, before the journey continues. From Hout Bay you will travel along Chapman's Peak Drive (photo stop) to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, where you will view both the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point. You will then make your way to Simon's Town, where a **seafood lunch** will be enjoyed at the Seaforth Restaurant. Finally, today you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Dinner will be optional tonight.

Overnight Cape Town

Day 4: Thursday, 14 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After a leisurely breakfast, you will be transferred to the Royal Cape Golf course (#42 in SA / 6 in the WC)(R2) for your next round of golf. After golf there will be time for some optional activities – you can choose from a wine tasting at Groot Constantia, so-called cradle of the South African wine industry, or you can make your way to Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, for a walk in this floral wonderland. In the late afternoon you return to your hotel for an evening at own leisure.

Overnight Cape Town

Day 5: Friday, 15 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After a leisurely breakfast, you will travel back to the Steenberg region for your next round of golf (R3). Mid-morning tee-times will be requested at the Steenberg Golf Club (#49 in SA / 7 in the WC). After golf it will be back to town and your V&A Hotel. Dinner will again be optional in the Waterfront precinct or similar.

Overnight Cape Town

Day 6: Saturday, 16 January 2027 (B / L / D)

Breakfast and check out is the start of an exciting day, when you will travel overland from the city, via Paarl and then the Huguenot Tunnel – longest road tunnel in Africa – to Worcester, De Doorns and Touws River, where you will enjoy **lunch** (12:00) and check in (14:00) at the Aquila Private Game Reserve, before the first (16:00) of 2 open vehicle game drives is enjoyed.

19:00/19:30 After the afternoon game drive, a scrumptious **buffet dinner** is enjoyed at the Lodge.

Overnight Touws River

Day 7: Sunday, 17 January 2027 (B / - / D)

06:00 An early morning wake-up call will get you out in your open vehicles for the second of your included game drives. The drive also includes a visit to the animal rehab centre at Aquila. On your return to the lodge (09:00), you will enjoy a buffet breakfast and then check out and start (10:00/10:30) your return trip back to Cape Town.

En route to the city, you will stop at Paarl for 18 holes of golf at the Paarl Golf Estate (#67 in SA / 11 in the WC)(R4). After golf, you then make your way to Stellenbosch. Check in at your hotel. **Dinner** will be enjoyed at a selected venue.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Protea Hotel by Marriot Stellenbosch (3*), R44, Stellenbosch

Day 8: Monday, 18 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After breakfast you will transfer to Somerset West and the Erinvale Golf Estate (#25 in SA / 3 in WC) on the slopes of the Helderberg Mountain for your next round of golf (R5). This course was home to the World Cup of Golf in 1996, which was won by Ernie Els and Wayne Westner. The front nine is quite flat, but the second nine's layout is up and down the slope of the Helderberg Mountain, making it a good challenge.

After golf you are returned to Stellenbosch, for an evening at own leisure. Dinner is optional at or near your hotel.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Day 9: Tuesday, 19 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After breakfast you will make your way to one of the top golf courses in the Western Cape. Your next round of golf (R6) will be played at the Arabella Golf Estate (#7 in SA / 2 in WC) near Kleinmond on the Bot River mouth. Depending on the available tee-times, you will stop at the Stony Point African penguin colony in Betty's Bay before or after golf.

Finally, you are returned to your hotel in Stellenbosch.

The evening is again spent at own leisure.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Day 10: Wednesday, 20 January 2027 (B / - / -)

Today is a free day. Optional golf or tourist arrangements can be made on request. Please discuss the options with your guide. Dinner is at own leisure.

Please note: Other than B&B accommodation, there are no other services included in the price for today. Any golf, travelling or touring activities – including trips to Robben Island or similar, **will be extra** on a user-pay-basis.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Day 11: Thursday, 21 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After breakfast you will make your way to the Stellenbosch Golf Club (#60 in SA / 10 in WC) – home of the South African Open (second oldest Open Championship in the world, after the British Open) in March 2026 – where you will play your next round of golf (R7). After golf and some social time at the course, you are returned (18:00) to your hotel.

Dinner at own leisure in Stellenbosch.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Day 12: Friday, 22 January 2027 (B / - / -)

After a leisurely breakfast your final round of golf will be enjoyed at the De Zalze Golf Estate (#31 in SA / 4 in WC)(R8). After golf, a short drive will get you to the De Zalze wine tasting center, for a tasting of some great wines. Finally, you are returned to your hotel.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Day 13: Saturday, 23 January 2027 (B / - / D)

On Saturdays, all clubs in South Africa have their members' competitions and finding tee-times can be a challenge. So, for today we suggest a day of wine tasting and touring. Depart from your hotel and go directly to Ernie Els Wines (early before they are busy), then maybe they will allow the bigger group all at the same time. From here you then make your way into Stellenbosch for a motorized and walking tour of this beautiful historic village. There will also be some free time to browse through a shop or two, for just the right memory to take back home. After **lunch** (South African braai [barbeque] with included wine tasting) at a selected venue you will visit another of the leading wine estates of the Stellenbosch region. A final wine tasting will be enjoyed here, before you are returned to your hotel in the late afternoon.

A **farewell dinner** will be included at a selected venue.

Overnight Stellenbosch

Day 14: Sunday, 24 January 2027 (B / meals on board)

On this last day of the tour, you can enjoy a leisurely breakfast at your hotel, as you prepare for your departure. The programme for the day, and the airport transfer, will be determined by your choice of airline.
