

The MEGA Safari – South Africa

The Western Cape, the Kruger and a leading private game lodge

Day 0: Saturday, 2026 (meals on board)

Overnight flight/s from Europe to Cape Town. Various airlines offer direct flights from European hubs to Cape Town.

Day 1: Sunday, 2026 (meals on board / - / D)

Your overnight flight should arrive in Cape Town before / by lunchtime. A meet and greet service will be supplied by Cape AgriTours. Your guide for the tour, will then assist you to your waiting touring coach/vehicle.

Weather permitting, you will make your way directly to Table Mountain, majestic sandstone bastion guarding over the “Mother City” of South Africa and one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature. There will be some free time on the mountain to enjoy something light to eat or simply enjoy your first beer on South African soil.

From the mountain your coach will then bring you to your hotel in the V&A Waterfront, where you can check in and relax.

Your welcome **dinner** will be enjoyed at selected venue close to the hotel.

Day 2: Monday, 2026 (B / L / -)

Today you are off to the land of “milk and honey”! Or let’s rather say food and wine! After an early breakfast, travel along the N1 highway, towards Paarl and Franschhoek – the valley of the Huguenots. Your first stop will be at the Drakenstein Prison, from where Mr Nelson Mandela was released in February 1990. There is a great statue of the statesman at the gate, and this makes for a good photo opportunity.

Then continue into the town of Franschhoek, the so-called French-corner of the Cape, for some free time to wonder down the main road with all its shops, before making your way to a selected Wine Estate (La Motte or Leopards Leap) for a wine tasting. After the tasting, a scenic drive will take you via Helshoogte Pass to a selected wine farm, where a **typical South African braai** (BBQ) will be enjoyed. A wine tasting of selected wines will complement your meal. Finally, today, on route back to the city, there will be time for one last wine tasting at a selected cellar.

In the late afternoon/early evening you will be returned to the hotel, for an evening spent at own leisure.

Overnight Cape Town

Day 3: Tuesday, 2026 (B / L / -)

No trip to South Africa can ever be complete with undertaking the Grand Tour of the Cape Peninsula.

Depart from your hotel, travelling via Maidens Cove (photo stop) to Hout Bay harbour, from where a short boat cruise will take you out to Duiker Island to view the colony of Cape fur seals and some other aquatic life. On your return to the mainland, there will be some free time to bargain with the curio traders on the quayside, before the journey continues southward on the Peninsula.

From Hout Bay you will travel along Chapman’s Peak Drive (photo stop) to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, where you will view both the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point. You will then make your way to Simon’s Town, where a **seafood lunch** will be enjoyed at the Seaforth Restaurant. After lunch, there will be time to visit the African penguin breeding colony on Boulders Beach, before finally today, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Dinner will be optional tonight.

Day 4: Wednesday, 2026 (B / - / D)

Today is spent at your own leisure in the City of Cape Town. The guide will be available to help you with anything you may want to do, giving advice and helping to buy any tickets you may need.

The afternoon, will also serve as back-up to get to Table Mountain, should this not have been possible on the first day.

Dinner will be enjoyed at a selected venue on the Camps Bay beach strip / or in the V&A Waterfront precinct.

Day 5: Thursday, 2026 (B / - / D)

After breakfast, you are transferred back to the Cape Town International Airport, for flight FA674 (10:40-13:10) directly to the Kruger- Mpumalanga Airport (MQP) near Nelspruit. Here a touring coach/vehicle will be ready, to take you directly to the Kruger National Park (KNP). Lunch will be optional along the way. On arrival at Skukuza, check in at the Skukuza Safari Lodge – a 4-star hotel in the main camp KNP. Included with your stay today, is a night safari with the open vehicles of the Parks Board.

Dinner is included with your stay.

Day 6: Friday, 2026 (B / - / D)

The full day (8 hours) is spent on safari in the Kruger Park. The vehicles travel in various directions, as they go in search of the best wildlife sightings they can get to. A lunch stop (optional meal) will be made at a selected venue in the park. The trip finishes back at the lodge in Skukuza.

Dinner is included with your stay.

Day 7: Saturday, 2026 (B / - / D)

The full day (8 hours) is spent on safari in the Kruger Park. The vehicles travel in various directions, as they go in search of the best wildlife sightings they can get to. A lunch stop (optional meal) will be made at a selected venue in the park. The trip finishes back at the lodge in Skukuza.

Dinner is included with your stay.

Overnight Skukuza

Day 8: Sunday, 2026 (B / L / D)

This morning after breakfast, your touring vehicle & guide, will collect you from the lodge, and then transfer you via Hazyview and Graskop, on to the Panorama Route of the Northern Drakensberg hills. This scenic drive exposes you to some of the most beautiful natural sites in South Africa. You can choose (arrange this with the guide) to visit any of the Pinnacle, Gods Window, Wonder View, the Potholes at Bourke's Luck, the 3 Rondavel view site over Blyde River Canyon – the largest green canyon in the world! – and one or more of the many waterfalls in the region. **Lunch** will be enjoyed at a riverside venue near to the Potholes. Finally, you will reach Hannah Lodge near Ohrigstad. Although this is a game reserve, no game activities are included with the stay. **Dinner** is included with your stay.

Day 9: Monday, 2026 (B / - / D)

After a leisurely breakfast and late check out, you now make your way to the Hoedspruit region, where an optional snack can be enjoyed at the Driehoek (the Triangle). From here you will make your way to the Moholoholo Animal Rehabilitation Centre for a 15:00 tour of the facility. After the tour, you will then check in at Forest Camp – luxury tents – nestled among trees that is a true birds watchers paradise. **Dinner** is included with your stay.

Day 10: Tuesday, 2026 (B / L / D)

After an early morning game drive and breakfast, you then check out from this lodge and your touring vehicle will take you via the town of Hoedspruit to the Kapama Private Game Reserve for a 3-night stay. Here you can stay and relax in the lap of luxury! During your stay, **all meals** and all local drinks are included, plus high tea in the afternoon, 2 game drives per day (early morning and sunset), and an optional bush walk every morning – this is a MUST DO. There is a wonderful spa facility (spa treatments are at extra cost), three swimming pools and a gym, which can all be use as much as you like. The daily programme is:

- Lunch on arrival
- High tea
- Sunset game drive and sundowners
- Dinner

Day 13: Friday, 2026 (B / meals on board)

As your final day in the African bush dawns, you are once again off into the bush on your last game drive. After breakfast, it is unfortunately time to say goodbye and then leave the bush behind you. You will now be transferred to the Hoedspruit Airport, from where there are 2 daily flights available to get you back to JNB, well in time to check in for your return flights to Europe. If you only depart the next day, special overnight arrangements will be made for you near the airport (3* / 4* / 5* options are available).
