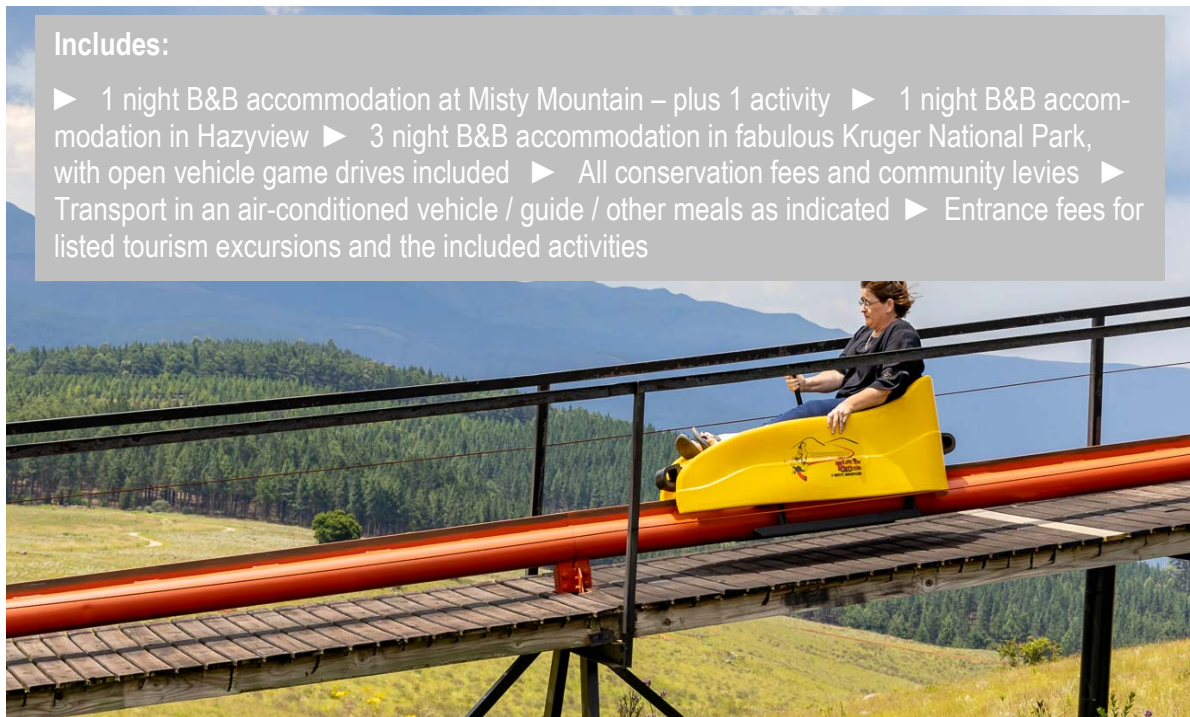
This is part 3 of the Get out, Get Active tours

Day 1: Saturday, 2026 (B / - / D)

End of Part 1 or Part 2 –

After an early breakfast and check out, you are transferred from the Stellenbosch hotel to Cape Town's International Airport to join a domestic flight directly to the Kruger-Mpumalanga International Airport (MQP) – flight FA670 (09:00-11:30). Your northern area guide and transport will be ready and waiting. Transfer from Mbombela (formerly Nelspruit) to the Long Tom Pass, and the Misty Mountain Resort. Lunch will be optional on route. Here you can simply enjoy the surrounds of the hotel, or you can indulge yourself in the activities available from Long Tom Toboggan!

Day 2: Sunday, 2026 (B / L / D)

As you may require some free time in the early morning, to partake in some of the activities, your stay at Misty Mountain can be extended for a few hours, or alternatively you will travel overland back via Sabie to Graskop and then on to the Panorama Route of the Northern Drakensberg. Sites that can be viewed, include the Pinnacle, God's Window, Wonder View, 1 or more of the many waterfalls in the area, the Potholes at Bourke's Luck (few 100m hiking) and the 3 Rondavels view site, to see Blyde River Canyon (the largest green canyon in the world!). **Lunch** is enjoyed at the Chubby Pig, a quaint old-style restaurant on the banks of the Treur River.

OPTIONS (if extending time):

- Toboggan ride – fast and furious!
- Quad biking
- Scootours

You will stay overnight with **dinner** included in Hazyview.

Day 3: Monday, 2026 (B / - / D)

Now the activities are OVER, and you start the real SAFARI! You will be collected at your hotel by the open safari vehicle/s and make your way straight to the Phabeni Gate of the Kruger National Park (KNP). The morning will be spent going in search of the BIG5 and all other animals of the African bush. A lunch break (optional meal) will be made at a selected venue, and then after lunch, you will slowly make your way to the Skukuza Rest Camp, to check in at your chosen accommodation. While you are on safari, your northern section guide will make his way directly to Skukuza with the luggage and check you in at the accommodation of choice. **Dinner** is included with your stay. When you reach the camp, you can get your accommodation (note the rustic huts are essentially self-catering), and there will be sufficient time to visit the shop in the camp, or to cool down at the swimming pool.

Skukuza Rest Camp (2* rustic huts) OR aha Skukuza Safari Lodge (4* hotel)

Day 4: Tuesday, 2026 (B / - / D)

This morning (06:00), you will once again meet up with the open game viewing vehicles and then be off on a full day (8 hours) safari in the KNP. A bush breakfast is included with your trip at one of the Bush Tearooms. Lunch is optional at a selected venue. You should be back at Skukuza by mid-afternoon, to relax and enjoy a swim. For this evening, we suggest an early **dinner** at Skukuza, and then you will join a night safari with the National Parks Board, as you go in search of some of the nocturnal creatures of the Park (can include the cats, hyena, genets, owls and more). Finally, you are returned to the camp for your overnight stay.

Day 5: Wednesday, 2026 (B / - / D)

The penultimate day of the tour is still on safari and will basically be a repeat of the day before. You will be out early, enjoy a bush breakfast, optional lunch at a selected stop, and then be returned to Skukuza for your final night in the KNP. **Dinner** is included with your stay.

Day 6: Thursday, 2025 (B / meals on board)

After breakfast and check out, your guide will bring you to either the Skukuza Airport or take you to the Kruger-Mpumalanga International Airport, for a domestic flight to JNB, where you will then join your return flight/s to Europe.

NOTE: There is also an option to further extend your trip to Zimbabwe and Botswana, with a regional flight from MQP to Victoria Falls. Speak to the team about detail for this.
